3	Pol Roger Brut Reserve n.v. Pol Roger Brut Réserve, made from equal parts of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier, is consistently one of the very best non-vintage cuvées on the market, largely due to the high proportion of aged reserve wines in the blend.		£73.00
4	Pol Roger Brut Vintage 2012 This beautiful Champagne uses fruit from 20 Grand and Premier Cru vineyards and is a blend of 60 percent Pinot Noir and 40 percent Chardonnay. Aged for eight years in the House cellars, this is a complex and layered wine. Stone fruit, lemon and grapefruit show on the nose; to taste, there's apple, stone fruit and citrus wrapped up with lovely, balanced acidity.		£110.00
5	Dom Perignon Vintage 2008 Notes of guava and spicy green grapefruit zest combine with stone fruit: white peach and nectarine. The wine opens up, and is complemented by woody vanilla and warm, lightly toasted brioche. The fruit is majestic: ripe, fleshy and deep. Beyond the richness and a certain voluptuousness is a strong impression of consistency that prevails. The wine's power is remarkably restrained.		£175.00

Arlauds Gevrey-Chambertin is from a 1 hectare vineyard and has a deep ruby/purple colour with a nose full of plum and black fruit aromas with hints of earth and leather. The palette is full and rounded with notes of strawberries and raspberries supported by fine tannins, lovely freshness and elegant acidity. **£69.50**

81. CHATEAU BATAILLEY 2005

Generous and ripe fruit on the nose. An effervescent bouquet with vibrant red berry fruit from this exceptional vintage. This is extremely well focused, with hints of rose petal. The palate is medium-bodied with a fine tannin background. A graphite-infused finish. Wonderful. **£105.00**

82. CHATEAU TALBOT 2009

The most impressive Talbot since 1986. Soft, supple and opulent, with notes of cedar, herbs, incense and blackcurrant. Full-bodied, generously endowed but silky. Lovely round, flattering fruit. Irresistible. **£115.00**

83. CHATEAU BATAILLEY 2014

Mid crimson. Ripe and heady with a floral aspect. An attractive bouquet, lilted scents of redcurrant and raspberry coulis, quite floral and very precise. The palate is medium-bodied with supple tannin, good depth and body. There is a sense of class to this Batailley. **£72.00**

84. CHATEAU GRUAUD LAROSE 2009

Lots of sleek polish and charm. It charges forth with warm black raspberries, crème de cassis and redcurrant jelly notes with touches of potpourri, cigar box, new leather, hoisin and molten chocolate. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is packed with black fruits and savoury layers with a firm, grainy texture and seamless freshness lifting the long earth-laced finish.

A refreshingly crisp wine with inviting aromas of fresh peach, leading to a vibrant palate of grapefruit and pear with a delicate hint of spice on the finish. **£24.95**
- 86. BOURGOGNE Domaine René Monnier, Burgundy, 2016**
Elegant style of Chardonnay with a lovely weight from the lees ageing. Notes of citrus are accompanied by elements of peach and pear on the full and beautifully balanced palate with a touch of minerality on the finish. A petit Meursault. **£39.95**

A classic and elegant white Burgundy, revealing ripe exotic fruit aromas complemented by delicate hints of oak spice. Its fresh style comes together with lovely fruit concentration to give good balance, with a smooth, round texture through to a long, persistent finish. **£45.65**
- 89. PERNAND-VERGELESSES Sylvain Loichet, Les Belles Filles, Burgundy 2015**
A wonderful example of a Pernand-Vergelesses with its mineral structure, typical of the appellation. Even with its taut character notes of white fruit come through on the palate, with good concentration and length. **£65.00**
